

## MESA HAS A NEW LOOK



**After 26 years The District 6600 MESA (Medical Equipment and Supplies Abroad) project now has the capability to go out and pick up donated items from Rotary Clubs and other organizations.**

MESA holds the medical supplies and equipment in a warehouse facility until it is containerized for shipment to those in need in other countries. MESA recently acquired this truck from an anonymous donor in order to help facilitate the transfer of donated items to our central location in Findlay. Originally owned by Findlay Ford it came to MESA with 152,000 well-traveled miles in 2007. PDG Dave Perkins and his design team came up with the logo design and Gary Davis our Logistics Manager repaired the rear roll up doors and had the logos installed in early June. Currently, the truck is headquartered at our new warehouse facility in Findlay and will be used by Rotarians for material pick up.



All Rotarians in District 6600 are members of the MESA project so in essence it is your truck. Why not take the opportunity to share in the MESA experience by asking local hospitals and other care facilities if there is some good serviceable equipment that they would be willing to donate. There are many less fortunate people in need in other countries that will put it to good use.
