Understanding the needs of receiving countries involves...

> **Establishing** a relationship in order to build a network of Rotary and community leaders in supported countries. Members of the MESA Steering Committee are regularly in contact with their counterparts in Central America. For other parts of the world, ad hoc project coordinators provide the communication necessary for mission success.

> **Participating** in project fairs in Central America. Each January, a country in Central America hosts a project fair known as the Uniendo Conference. Rotarians from all over North America join in to help identify the needs and plan strategies in the fight against the ravages of disease, hunger, illiteracy, and poverty.
